

## What to expect on your safari TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK: Day 2

One of the lesser-known game reserves in Tanzania, Tarangire rivals the Serengeti in its great number and diversity of wildlife. The Tarangire National Park is known as a wonderful birding destination and also features large numbers of game. In particular, Tarangire is known to host some of the largest elephant heards in Africa and dramatic interactions between predator and prey at the park water holes.

### What to expect on your safari LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK: Day 3

Lake Manyara National Park centres around its eponymous alkaline lake, a key habitat for hundreds of bird species. It is home to a famous tree-climbing lion population and a large variety of eco-systems ranging from steep mountainside and dense woodlands to Rift Valley soda lake. There is always something interesting to see and experience in the Lake Manyara region.

## What to expect on your safari CENTRAL SERENGETI: Day 4-5

The Serengeti in Tanzania is undoubtedly the best-known wildlife sanctuary in the world. With countless predators and millions of wildebeests and zebras, the vast plains of the Serengeti will offer you unforgettable memories. The Central Serengeti is studded with many rocky granite outcrops, known as kopjes, where you will be looking out for lions, and cheetahs. Thick woodland is home to several varieties of primates from vervet monkeys, olive baboons to bushbabies and on the plains, elephants are seen in numbers.

### What to expect on your safari NORTHERN SERENGETI: Day 6-7

Every year, one of the most extraordinary wildlife event is taking place. Over a million wildebeest and several hundred thousands zebra undertake a year-long migration through the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem in search of nutritious grass and water. The migration takes place from the Ngorongoro Conservation area, up the Serengeti to the Maasai Mara and back again. From August to October, witness large gatherings of wildebeest ready to overcome all dangers to cross the Mara river.

### What to expect on your safari NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA: Day 4

Ngorogoro crater, the largest inactive, intact and unflooded caldera in the world, was formed when a volcano exploded and collapsed in on itself 2 to 3 million years ago. It is now one of the best places in Africa for wildlife viewing, with the Big 5 and an extraordinary concentration of predators in the area.

#### DAY 1

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by your guide. After greetings, you'll will be transferred to Arusha for a safari briefing, and overnight stay. Breakfast will be provided at the hotel.

Main Destination: Arusha Meals: Bed & breakfast Drinks not included

#### DAY 2

After breakfast at your hotel your driver guide will pick you up and head off to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire National Park is famous for its large elephant herds. The park is second only to Ngorongoro Crater in concentration of wildlife and is home to more than 500 species of bird. Thousands of parched animals flock to the water holes and thousands more makes their long way to the permanent water of the Tarangire River.

Main Destination: Tarangire National Park Meals: All meals included Drinking water 1.5 liter (Other drinks not included)

### DAY 3

Today after breakfast drive to Lake Manyara National Park. Explore the deep forest where the big tuskers are roaming, the blue monkeys jump from the top branches of the ancient tamarind, mahogany and giant's baobab, using their tail as an extra limb. Visit the lake shore where you can spot pink and lesser flamingo's hippos and storks.

Main Destination: Lake Manyara National Park Meals: All meals included Drinking water 1.5 liter (Other drinks not included)

#### DAY 4

Today, enjoy the beautiful Serengeti sunrise in the morning, and witness the sea of waving grass and the rocky hills. The central Serengeti is know for its large number of cats and big birds.

Main Destination: Serengeti National Park Meals: All meals included Drinking water 1.5 liter (Other drinks not included)

### DAY BY DAY

#### DAY 5-6

After breakfast drive to Northern Serengeti. You will spend these 2 days searching for the Migration crossing the Mara River.

#### DAY 7

Early morning game drive in Northern Serengeti with game on route to Central Serengeti the home of migration and the big cats, meet the sea of the waving grass, the rock outcrop, the endless plain Serengeti has it all. Overnight at Sound of silence on Full board basis for one night in central Serengeti.


### DAY 8

Today after breakfast at the lodge, drive to the crater floor. Ngorongoro Crater was formed from a collapsed volcano. It's now a self-sustaining ecosystem with the densest predator population in all of Africa – you may be able to spot the Big 5 in a single afternoon.

Main Destination: Ngorongoro crater Meals: All meals included Drinking water 1.5 liter (Other drinks not included)

After breakfast drive to Arusha for your flight back home. Karibu tena! (Welcome again!) Main Destination: Arusha Meals: breakfast & lunch Drinking water 1.5 liter (Other drinks not included)
